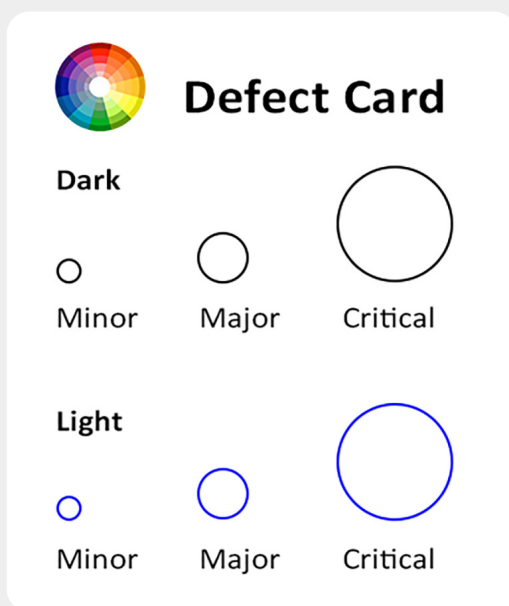
## Defects Blue

Every possible black, blue, brown defects and peel residue are defects. They are rated by colour intensity and sorted in acceptable, light and dark defects.

Black defects are always classified in the category “dark”.

Blue and brown defects are sorted with this potato card in colour: “dark and light”.

The defects are then further classified by size in Minor, Major, or Critical with the use of the Defect Card.



### Dimension Defects

#### Dark:

Critical > 14.3mm

Major 6 - 14.3mm

Minor 3 - 6mm

#### Light:

Critical > 14.3mm

Major 8 - 14.3mm

Minor 5 - 8mm

#### Specifications (light & dark):

Critical MAX 0pcs/2500g

Major MAX 11pcs/2500g

Minor MAX 50pcs/2500g
